

## PNP EXAMINATION ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Police Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the Philippine National Police (PNP), will conduct nationwide the

### PNP ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

on

**MAY 26, 2013**

The PNP ENTRANCE EXAMINATION is open to all Filipino citizens who meet the age, height and educational requirements as provided herein, as well as to Police Officers I (PO1) whose appointments are temporary for lack of appropriate eligibility. Those who pass this examination are conferred by the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) the PNP Entrance eligibility which is appropriate for appointment to the rank of PO1, as prescribed under Sec. 30 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551.

#### V. HOW TO GET A SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT FOR FILING OF APPLICATION FOR THE PNP ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

1. A. Applicant logs on to the NAPOLCOM official website at [www.napolcom.gov.ph](http://www.napolcom.gov.ph) or [www.napolcom-online.com](http://www.napolcom-online.com), clicks on the ON-LINE EXAMINATION APPLICATION SCHEDULING SYSTEM and fills out the mandatory fields as follows:
  - Last Name
  - First Name
  - Middle Name
  - Email Address
  - Home Address
  - Cellphone No.
  - Preferred Exam Center (for regional office with two (2) or more Exam Centers)
  - Exam Title





Additional mandatory fields to be filled out by Entrance Exam applicants:

- Gender
- Height
- Age
- Birthdate
- Course Completed
- Name of School

2. A. Applicant clicks **SUBMIT** after filling out the mandatory fields. A **CONFIRMATION** will appear if submission was successful. If not, the process should be repeated.
- B. Applicant waits for the letter-reply which will be sent to the email address he/she registered, confirming his/her scheduled appointment for filing his/her application for the PNP Entrance Examination.
- C. Applicant prints the letter-reply and presents/submits it, together with the other requirements, to the Exam Processor at the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where he/she prefers to take the examination.

### IMPORTANT

Applicant must be at the NAPOLCOM Regional Office at least 15 minutes prior to his/her scheduled appointment date with all the requirements.

## VI. WHERE TO GET APPLICATION FORMS AND INDEX CARDS

Application Forms (NAPOLCOM Form 1-A) and Index Cards can be obtained for FREE at any *NAPOLCOM Regional Office nationwide*, or may be downloaded from the NAPOLCOM website at [www.napolcom.gov.ph](http://www.napolcom.gov.ph). These may also be REPRODUCED using the original size of the Application Form and Index Card.

## VII. HOW TO FILE

An applicant should file his/her application, together with all the required supporting documents, on his/her scheduled appointment **PERSONALLY** only at the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where he/she intends to take the examination. **APPLICATIONS RECEIVED THRU POSTAL MAIL SHALL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

## VIII. WHAT TO BRING WHEN FILING

1. Printed letter-reply/corresponding reference number confirming the scheduled appointment
2. An Application Form (NAPOLCOM Form 1-A) and Index Card, duly accomplished by the applicant and two (2) recent and identical 1" x 1" ID pictures (in color) with white background and complete name tag (indicate rank before the first, middle and last names, if PNP member)
3. **Police Examination Fee:** Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00)

### NO OTHER FEES SHALL BE COLLECTED.

4. One (1) legal-size window envelope with nine pesos (P9.00) worth of mailing stamps (for NCR, CAR, Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5) and twelve pesos (P12.00) worth of mailing stamps (for Visayas, Mindanao, Occidental and Oriental Mindoro, and Palawan)
5. Transcript of Scholastic Record (*with Special Order issued by CHED*) or Diploma from CHED-accredited schools, state universities and colleges.
6. Birth Certificate issued by the Local Civil Registrar (LCR) or by the main and field offices of the National Statistics Office (NSO)
7. For a PO1 with temporary appointment, a certified true copy of Attested Appointment, Plantilla Appointment or Special Order.

An examinee who fails in an exam or after being admitted to take said exam, fails to take it for one reason or another, **need not resubmit the requirements** should he/she apply again for the same exam in the same exam center. The applicant will only have to: (a) submit the **ADMISSION SLIP** of the last exam applied for; (b) fill out a new application form and index card with ID pictures; and, (c) pay the examination fee.



## IX. NOTIFICATION OF EXAMINATION

A qualified applicant shall be issued a Notice of Admission on the day he/she files his/her application for the examination. However, to confirm the status of said application, he/she may verify from the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where said application was filed.

\*\*NAPOLCOM MC No. 2007-009, Sec.7 Item No. 4, as amended by NAPOLCOM MC No. 2011-001, provides that the minimum height requirement for PNP applicants who are members of indigenous communities shall be 1.52 meters for males and 1.45 meters for females. For examination purposes, they are required to submit a Certification of their tribal membership issued by the Main Office of the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) or the Office on Muslim Affairs (OMA) (now National Commission on Muslim Filipinos (NCMF)), or a Height Waiver issued by the NAPOLCOM.



#### XIV. NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS:

The nationwide List of Successful Examinees will be posted at the NAPOLCOM Central Office located at 371 Senator Gil J. Puyat Avenue, Makati City and at the NAPOLCOM website. Similarly, a Regional List will be posted in each of the NAPOLCOM Regional Offices.

**EXAMINATION RESULTS** – Report of Rating (RR) will be mailed to the examinee's mailing address. Verification may be made with the Examination Division, Personnel and Administrative Service (PAS), NAPOLCOM Central Office. An examinee who passed the test but did not receive his/her RR may request for the issuance of a certification from the same office, upon payment of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P150.00). For requests sent through postal mail, payment shall be in money order form payable to the National Police Commission, # 371 Senator Gil J. Puyat Avenue, Makati City 1200.

#### XV. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

It is understood that all data written by the applicant on the Application Form and Index Card, including information contained in the required submitted documents are considered TRUE AND CORRECT and shall be treated as official data. AN APPLICANT'S QUALIFICATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO FINAL REVIEW AND VERIFICATION BY THE EXAMINATION DIVISION, PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE (PAS), NAPOLCOM CENTRAL OFFICE. AN APPLICANT MAY BE REQUIRED TO PRESENT ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY. THE TEST RESULT OF AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE CANCELLED/INVALIDATED IF IT IS ESTABLISHED THAT HE/SHE DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR THE EXAMINATION.

THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION HAS A COMPUTER SYSTEM THAT KEEPS TRACK OF THE ANSWER PATTERNS OF EXAMINEES. IF TWO OR MORE EXAMINEES HAVE A HIGH PERCENTAGE OF SIMILAR ANSWER PATTERNS, THIS SHALL RESULT IN THE INVALIDATION OF THEIR TEST RESULTS.
